## Overview of Books

---

### Jeremiah

- AUTHOR: Jeremiah
- RECIPIENTS: Israel
- TIME: 627-585 B.C.
- PEOPLE: Jeremiah; Nebuchadnezzar
- EVENTS: Political upheaval between Judah, Egypt and Babylon; Destruction of Jerusalem and deportation of the Jews to Babylon
- BIG IDEAS: God's judgment on Judah for their idolatry; God's willingness to spare and bless His people if only they will repent ; A future restoration and new covenant

### Lamentations

- AUTHOR: Jeremiah
- RECIPIENTS: Israel
- TIME: 586 B.C.
- PEOPLE: Residents of Jerusalem
- EVENTS: The two year siege and fall of Jerusalem
- BIG IDEAS: The juxtaposition of suffering and hope

### Colossians

- AUTHOR: Paul
- RECIPIENTS: Church of Colosse
- TIME: A.D. 60-62
- PEOPLE: Timothy, Aristarchus, Archippus, Mark, Epaphras, Luke, Onesimus, and Demas
- EVENTS: Epaphras found this church; a heresy called Gnosticism is plaguing the church
- BIG IDEAS: The deity of Christ; Christian behavior

### I&II Thessalonians

- AUTHOR: Paul
- RECIPIENTS: Church of Thessalonica
- TIME: A.D. 51 Probably the first document of the New Testament
- PEOPLE: Paul, Timothy, Silvanus
- EVENTS: The ongoing persecution and suffering of the new Gentile converts; Misrepresentation of Paul's teaching on Christ's 2nd Coming
- BIG IDEAS: Suffering as a part of the Christian life; Christian work ethic; sexual holiness; what happens to believers who have died before the return of Christ

## Overview of Books - cont.

### I&II Timothy

- AUTHOR: Paul
- RECIPIENTS: Timothy & Church at Ephesus
- TIME: A.D. 62-63 ; 67
- PEOPLE: Timothy; false teachers; widows; Elders
- EVENTS: Misleading teaching of Elders from within; Paul's imprisonment in Rome; Paul's execution in Rome
- BIG IDEAS: Qualifications for Elders; Refuting false doctrine and teachers; Loyalty to Paul, his gospel, his God; Pastors are to be faithful men preaching the Scriptures relentlessly

### Titus

- AUTHOR: Paul
- RECIPIENTS: Titus
- TIME: A.D. 62-64
- PEOPLE: Titus
- EVENTS: Titus is to silence false teachers and rebuke those who follow them
- BIG IDEAS: Believers are to be good and do good; qualified Elders are to guard sound faith and doctrine

### Philemon

- AUTHOR: Paul
- RECIPIENTS: Philemon and the church in his home
- TIME: A.D. 60-61
- PEOPLE: Philemon; Onesimus; Tychicus
- EVENTS: Under Paul's ministry runaway slave Onesimus is saved and sent back to his master, Philemon; Philemon is urged by Paul to forgive and receive Onesimus as a brother in Christ.
- BIG IDEAS: Forgiveness

### Hebrews

- AUTHOR: Unknown
- RECIPIENTS: A Community of Jewish believers
- TIME: A.D. 67-69
- PEOPLE: Jewish Christians who suffered rejection and persecution by fellow Jews; Jewish unbelievers
- EVENTS: Persecution that is tempting the suffering believers to abandon the purity of their new faith.
- BIG IDEAS: Believers in Jesus Christ, as God's perfect sacrifice for sin, have the perfect High-Priest through whose ministry everything is new and better than under the covenant of law
